SGA High Performance KPI (Updated 21st Jan 2021)

Selection criteria as follows:

- ✓ *Singaporean citizen*
- ✓ *Meet Performance Criteria. (See below)*
- ✓ *Athletes will have to meet Tier 1 criteria to be eligible for Elite Bonus of \$1,000 per quarter for training/tournament expenses*
- ✓ *SGA will have the sole management and control of the SGA OoM, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Conditions*
- ✓ *SGA's decision on matters regarding the selection will be final*
- ✓ *The Performance Criteria is one of the tools used for selection/demotion by the Training and Development Committee*
- ✓ *Analysis and input from the National Coach from training and tournament performance will be used for selection as well*
- ✓ *By meeting two of the following set of criteria does not guarantee entry or selection but increases the possibility of selection*
- ✓ *Major Games/Team Events will have their own set of Selection Policy for the respective tournaments*

Performance Criteria:

MEN

National Squad Athlete (Men) - Tier 1

(Players must meet two of the following criteria to gain possible selection)

- WAGR Top 100
- Top 3 – Asia-Pacific Amateur Championship
- Winner of event with WAGR Power of 300 and above

National Squad Athlete (Men) - Tier 2 (Remain in/Qualify for the National Squad)

(Players must meet two of the following criteria to gain possible selection)

- WAGR Top 800 as of 31 December
- Top 20 Asia-Pacific Amateur Championship
- Top 8 in an event with WAGR Power of 300 and above
- Winner of an event with WAGR Power of 150 and above

- Winner of two National Ranking Games
- Achieve a maximum stroke average of 74.0 within the calendar year with a minimum of 15 rounds (must be WAGR-ranked or SGA approved events)
- Top 2 - SGA Order of Merit (Men)

Development Squad Athlete (Men) – Tier 3 (Remain in/Qualify for Development Squad)

(Players must meet two of the following criteria to gain possible selection)

- WAGR Top 3000 as of 31 December
- Overall Top 5 in an event with WAGR Power of 100 and above
- Top 2 of a National Ranking Game (Men Open)
- Top 15 in an event with WAGR Power of 300 and above
- Top 5 - SGA Order of Merit (Men)
- Top 2 – SGA Order of Merit (Under 17)
- Top 10 - Singapore Junior Championship (Open)
- Achieve a maximum stroke average of 77.0 during the calendar year with a minimum of 15 rounds (must be WAGR-ranked or SGA approved events)
- Shows progression relative to the athlete's age and stage of development (tournaments, trainings, skills tests) *at discretion of National Coach & High-Performance Manager

Junior Squad (Boys) – Tier 4 (Remain in/Qualify for Junior Squad)

(Players must meet two of the following criteria to gain possible selection)

- Top 3 in Division – HSBC Youth Golf Challenge/SICC Junior Invitational/NSRCC Junior
- Top 5 in Division – Singapore Junior Championship
- Top 2 in a National Ranking Game (Boys Under 17)
- Top 5 – SGA Order of Merit (Boys Under 17)
- 85% Training Attendance (Golf/Gym)
- Meets benchmark for skills tests developed by National Coach
- Shows progression relative to the athlete's age and stage of development (tournaments, trainings, skills tests) *at discretion of National Coach & High-Performance Manager

National Squad Athlete (Women) - Tier 1

(Players must meet two of the following criteria to gain possible selection)

- WAGR Top 300
- Top 10 – Women’s Amateur Asia-Pacific
- Winner of event with WAGR Power of 200 and above

National Squad Athlete (Women) - Tier 2 (Remain in/Qualify for the National Squad)

(Players must meet two of the following criteria to gain possible selection)

- WAGR Top 1200
- Top 30 - Women’s Amateur Asia Pacific
- Top 8 in an event with WAGR Power of 150 and above
- Winner of an event with WAGR Power of 75 and above
- Winner of two events with WAGR Power of below 75
- Achieve a maximum stroke average of 76.0 within the calendar year with a minimum of 15 rounds (must be WAGR-ranked or SGA approved events)
- Top 2 – SGA Order of Merit (Women)

Development Squad Athlete (Women) – Tier 3 (Remain in/Qualify for the Development Squad)

(Players must meet two of the following criteria to gain possible selection)

- Overall Top 5 in an event with WAGR Power of 75 and above
- Winner in an event with WAGR Power of below 75
- Top 15 in an event with WAGR Power of 150 and above
- Top 5 - Singapore Junior Championship (Open)
- Top 2 in a National Ranking Game (Women Open)
- Top 5 SGA Order of Merit (Women)

- Top 2 of SGA Order of Merit (Girls Under 17)
- Achieve a maximum stroke average of 79.0 during the calendar year with a minimum of 15 rounds (must be WAGR-ranked or SGA approved events)
- Shows progression relative to the athlete's age and stage of development (tournaments, trainings, skills tests) *at discretion of National Coach & High-Performance Manager

Junior Squad (Girls) – Tier 4 (Remain in/Qualify for Junior Squad)

(Players must meet two of the following criteria to gain possible selection)

- Top 3 in Division – HSBC Youth Golf Challenge/SICC Junior Invitational/NSRCC Junior
- Top 3 in Division - Singapore Junior Championship
- Top 2 of a National Ranking Game (Girls Under 17)
- Top 5 of SGA Order of Merit (Girls Under 17)
- 85% Training Attendance (Golf/Gym)
- Meets benchmark for skills tests developed by National Coach
- Shows progression relative to the athlete's age and stage of development (tournaments, trainings, skills tests) *at discretion of National Coach & High-Performance Manager
